Easter 2019

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On that first Easter, the grief of the weeping Mary Magdalene turned to joy when the Risen Christ revealed himself to her at the empty tomb. Calling her by name Jesus sent her to bring good news to the disciples that he lives forever more – he wished to meet them, instruct them, and send them.

In trembling joy Mary Magdalene ran from the empty tomb to the Cenacle where the apostles hid for fear that their association with the crucified Jesus could seal for them a similar fate. Reaching them, she announced with efficacious joy, *I have seen the Lord*. With those words history pivoted into a definitive change forever more.

This Easter, two millennia later, we are in an era of a universal and unprecedented diabolical disorientation. The great apostasy forewarned by the Lord is a present day reality. Doctrinal, spiritual, and moral corruption at all levels of the Church are ever before us. Fear and distrust leave us feeling overly stressed, full of anxiety, and wondering to whom we shall go. Who will deliver us from the deceit that allures us to the demise of things familiar and sacred? To whom do we have recourse?

As happens when history dangles on the precipice of doom and the Church with it, a light begins to emerge from the dark, a fragrance begins to dispel the stench of impending death, and good sets out in defeat of evil. Humble forces are awakened that confound the high and mighty to topple them from their pedestals of power that the reign of the Risen One be restored.

Do not underestimate the subtle ways the Risen Lord reminds us to fear not – to be at peace – to move forward, a humble force in mission. At this crucial moment in time, here at *St. Stanislaus Kostka - Sanctuary of the Divine Mercy*, a long hidden masterpiece is providentially *unveiled* and a prophetic treasure again graces the Archdiocese of Chicago. The mural named *Triumph of the Risen Christ*, after decades in eclipse, bespeaks to the disciples of our age an answer to our woes.

In the mural the *Ancients of Old – Saints of the Past*, hidden from our view are now shown anew with a simple yet poignant message:

Turn your eyes to the Risen Lord and pick up where we left off. We are with you. We intercede on your behalf. The victory that is ours is yours as well. In our time we fought the good fight. You do the same in yours. With us, joyfully proclaim: "We have seen the Lord." Now the Risen Lord wishes to meet you, instruct you, and send you. He calls you by name. The trajectory of history is toward the Beatific Vision. Eyes fixed on the Risen Lord you are charged to lead the way. Go now, the night is near the day far spent. Fear not! Peace unto you! He reigns forever more.

Pascua 2019

Estimados Hermanos y Hermanas en Cristo,

En esa primera Pascua, la aflicción de la llorosa María Magdalena se convirtió en júbilo cuando el Cristo Resucitado se reveló a Sí mismo a ella en la tumba vacía. Llamándola por su nombre Jesús la envió a que le llevara la Buena Nueva a los discípulos de que Él vive para siempre – Él deseaba reunirse con ellos, enseñarlos, y enviarlos.

Con un júbilo tembloroso María Magdalena corrió de la tumba vacía hacia el Cenáculo donde los apóstoles se escondían temiendo que su asociación con el Jesús crucificado podía sellarles la misma suerte. Al llegar con ellos, les anunció ella con júbilo eficaz, *he visto al Señor*. Con esas palabras la historia giró hacia un cambio definitivo para siempre.

Esta Pascua, dos mil años después, nos encontramos en una era de una universal desorientación diabólica sin precedentes. La gran apostasía advertida por el Señor es hoy una realidad. La corrupción doctrinal, espiritual, y moral a diferentes niveles de la Iglesia están muy presentes. El temor y la desconfianza nos dejan sintiéndonos extremadamente estresados, llenos de ansiedad, y pensando a quién iremos. ¿Quién nos liberará del engaño que nos seduce a la destrucción de las cosas conocidas y sagradas? ¿A quién recurrimos?

Como sucede cuando la historia cuelga del precipicio de la condena y la Iglesia consigo, una luz comienza a salir de la obscuridad, una fragancia comienza a desvanecer el apeste de la muerte inminente, y el bien sale derrotando la maldad. Las fuerzas humildes son despiertas las cuales confunden a los de posiciones altas y poderosas para tumbarlos de sus pedestales de poder para que el reino del Resucitado sea restaurado.

No bajo estimen las formas sutiles que el Señor Resucitado nos recuerda que no temamos – de mantener la paz – de caminar hacia delante, una fuerza humilde en misión. En este tiempo importante, aquí en *San Estanislao Kostka – Santuario de la Divina Misericordia*, una obra maestra ocultada por un largo tiempo es providencialmente *desvelada* y un Tesoro profético de nuevo gracia a la Arquidiócesis de Chicago. El mural nombrado el *Triunfo del Cristo Resucitado*, después de décadas en eclipse, les habla a los discípulos de nuestro tiempo como una respuesta a nuestros sufrimientos.

En el mural los *Antepasados – Los Santos del Pasado*, ocultos de nuestra vista ahora son mostrados de nuevo con un simple pero conmovedor mensaje:

Voltea tu mirada al Señor Resucitado y continúa tu camino donde lo dejamos. Estamos contigo. Intercedemos en tu nombre. La Victoria de nosotros es también tu Victoria. En nuestro tiempo dimos la buena pelea. También haz lo mismo en tu tiempo. Proclama con júbilo con nosotros: “Hemos visto al Señor” Ahora el Señor Resucitado desea reunirse contigo, para enseñarte, y enviarte. Te llama por tu nombre. La trayectoria de la historia es hacia la Visión Beatífica. La mirada puesta firmemente sobre el Señor Resucitado ya que eres encomendado para guiar el camino. Mira, la noche se aproxima ya que el día está por terminarse. ¡No temas! ¡La paz está contigo! Él reina por siempre más.

Novena to The Divine Mercy, April 19 – April 27, 2019 -- The Daily Intentions

Jesus asked that the Feast of the Divine Mercy be preceded by a Novena to the Divine Mercy and gave St. Faustina the following instruction as recorded in her diary, **“On each day of the novena you will bring to My heart a different group of souls and you will immerse them in this ocean of My mercy...”**

Day 1 Good Friday

"Today, bring to Me all mankind, especially all sinners, and immerse them in the ocean of My mercy. In this way you will console Me in the bitter grief into which the loss of souls plunges Me."

Day 2 Holy Saturday

"Today, bring to Me the Souls of Priests and Religious and immerse them in My unfathomable mercy. It was they who gave me strength to endure My bitter Passion. Through them as through channels My mercy flows out upon mankind."

Day 3 Easter Sunday

"Today, bring to Me all Devout and Faithful Souls, and immerse them in the ocean of My mercy. These souls brought me consolation on the Way of the Cross. They were a drop of consolation in the midst of an ocean of bitterness."

Day 4 Monday of Easter Week

"Today, bring to Me those who do not believe in God and those who do not know Me. I was thinking also of them during My bitter Passion, and their future zeal comforted My Heart. Immerse them in the ocean of My mercy."

Day 5 Tuesday of Easter Week

"Today, bring to Me the Souls of those who have separated themselves from My Church and immerse them in the ocean of My mercy. During My bitter Passion they tore at My Body and Heart, that is, My Church. As they return to unity with the Church My wounds heal and in this way they alleviate My Passion."

Day 6 Wednesday of Easter Week

"Today, bring to Me the Meek and Humble Souls and the Souls of Little Children and immerse them in My mercy. These souls most closely resemble My Heart. They strengthened Me during My bitter agony. I saw them as earthly Angels, who will keep vigil at My altars. I pour out upon them whole torrents of grace. I favor humble souls with My confidence."

Day 7 Thursday of Easter Week

"Today, bring to Me the Souls who especially venerate and glorify My Mercy and immerse them in My mercy. These souls sorrowed most over my Passion and entered most deeply into My spirit. They are living images of My Compassionate Heart. These souls will shine with a special brightness in the next life. Not one of them will go into the fire of hell. I shall particularly defend each one of them at the hour of death."

Day 8 Friday of Easter Week

"Today, bring to Me the Souls who are in the prison of Purgatory and immerse them in the abyss of My mercy. Let the torrents of My Blood cool down their scorching flames. All these souls are greatly loved by Me. They are making retribution to My justice. It is in your power to bring them relief. Draw all the indulgences from the treasury of My Church and offer them on their behalf. Oh, if you only knew the torments they suffer, you would continually offer for them the alms of the spirit and pay off their debt to My justice."

Day 9 Saturday of Easter Week – Vigil Divine Mercy Sunday

"Today bring to Me the Souls who have become lukewarm, and immerse them in the abyss of My mercy. These souls wound My Heart most painfully. My soul suffered the most dreadful loathing in the Garden of Olives because of lukewarm souls. They were the reason I cried out: 'Father, take this cup away from Me, if it be Your will.' For them, the last hope of salvation is to run to My mercy."

HOW WE PRAY AT ST. STANISLAUS KOSTKA

WE KEEP OUR DOORS OPEN ALL DAY AND ALL NIGHT:

We listen. In response to the call of the Blessed Virgin Mary we strive to create quiet refuge from the labor of life's journey where the soul is opened to the transforming power of God's ever abiding presence. The grace of the *Holy Eucharist* will assist a covenant people on its return to childlike trust in Jesus, provide healing and strength, and inspire enthusiasm for the work of life. Therefore we wish to safeguard sacred silence in this sanctuary that God's voice is heard in the deep recesses of the soul.

WE OFFER THE SACRED MYSTERIES AD ORIENTEM:

The *Sacred Mysteries* are offered as they were for nearly 2000 years. Today, while the *ordinary form* for offering the *Holy Eucharist* has the priest facing the *sacred assembly*, here we follow an ancient form of the *Holy Offering*, the priest and the people together, raising their eyes to the *East* from where the Lord will come at the end of all things.

This option for offering the *Sacred Mysteries* was nearly universally eclipsed in the aftermath of the Second Vatican Council beginning in the mid-1960s, but Pope Benedict, Cardinal Sarah, and other Church Fathers have inspired a resurgence of this ancient gesture for offering the *Liturgy of the Holy Eucharist*.

At the *Altar of Sacrifice*, the *priest* lays down his life and the *sacred assembly* does likewise. This is our mutual *fiat* – our *yes* spoken and offered in thanksgiving that the Lord receive us as a people in need of redemption. The Lord indeed comes to us with redeeming grace. Together, priest and people offer themselves in Christ and through Christ to the Father. Ours is a plea that God make all things new and keep us on the narrow, but difficult path that serves humanity even as it carries us to the homeland. Our turning *Ad Orientem* facilitates a proper response to having been fed with the *Word of God* as well as an appropriate preparation for the *Supper of the Lamb*.

WE OFFER TWO OPTIONS FOR THE RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION:

After the Second Vatican Council, standing for reception of the *Holy Eucharist* became the norm and fits the directives of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. Nonetheless, kneeling to receive Jesus in *Holy Communion* is in keeping with the enduring tradition of our ancestors. Today the option to kneel or stand rests with the individual. Likewise, the option to receive the *Holy Eucharist* on the tongue or on the hand rests with the individual.

Whichever manner we choose to receive Jesus in the *Holy Eucharist*, let us be conscious of this sacred and life sustaining encounter. Let us receive Him in grace and with gratitude, humbly and in humility.
