LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

By now you've taken note of the scaffolding in the sanctuary and I'm sure you're asking what's going on. Over the years we've been blessed in many ways and here we have another example of God's benevolence in regard to this historic church. A donor who wishes anonymity has made a specific request that the dome mural depicting "The Triumph of the Risen Christ" be restored.

Parma Conservation has been commissioned for the restoration of the mural which will entail cleaning of the mural, removal of old varnish, in-fill of missing paint, plaster repair, and recoating the mural with fresh varnish. A team of about ten artisans and conservationists will begin work on the mural this week. The project is expected to take about two months and is expected to be completed by Holy Week.

The parish church has been undergoing restoration for nearly ten years. Having our doors open 24/7 has allowed people to enjoy some solitude and prayer in a sanctuary that is beautiful, clean, and enveloped in *sacred silence*. This is wholly unique in our day and age and it's through the generosity of donors that we are able to provide such a service to the people of Chicago. I trust you will keep the donors in your prayers that their contributions to the restoration of St. Stan's not be outdone by God's blessing to them.

I want to thank all of you as well for your fidelity to the faith and for your ongoing support to St. Stanislaus Kostka. Here we remain grounded as we confront the challenges of daily life. Not only are we grounded, but we call this our spiritual home. We want it to be beautiful and open not only for our own benefit, but for the benefit of others. Anyone who comes through the doors of St. Stan's should feel at home.

Speaking of support and generosity for the parish, today we make our personal pledges to the Annual Catholic Appeal. The Archdiocese assigns us a goal of 6% of our previous year's offertory income. For Fiscal Year 2017-1018, St. Stanislaus Kostka's offertory income was \$351,930. Therefore, our target for the 2019 Appeal is \$21,116. Anything we contribute over and above the \$21,116 goal will come back to St. Stanislaus Kostka.

HOW WE PRAY AT ST. STANISLAUS KOSTKA

WE KEEP OUR DOORS OPEN ALL DAY AND ALL NIGHT:

We listen. In response to the call of the Blessed Virgin Mary we strive to create quiet refuge from the labor of life's journey where the soul is opened to the transforming power of God's ever abiding presence. The grace of the *Holy Eucharist* will assist a covenant people on its return to childlike trust in Jesus, provide healing and strength, and inspire enthusiasm for the work of life. Therefore we wish to safeguard sacred silence in this sanctuary that God's voice is heard in the deep recesses of the soul.

WE OFFER THE SACRED MYSTERIES AD ORIENTEM:

The *Sacred Mysteries* are offered as they were for nearly 2000 years. Today, while the *ordinary form* for offering the *Holy Eucharist* has the priest facing the *sacred assembly*, here we follow an ancient form of the *Holy Offering*, the priest and the people together, raising their eyes to the *East* from where the Lord will come at the end of all things.

This option for offering the *Sacred Mysteries* was nearly universally eclipsed in the aftermath of the Second Vatican Council beginning in the mid-1960s, but Pope Benedict, Cardinal Sarah, and other Church Fathers have inspired a resurgence of this ancient gesture for offering the *Liturgy of the Holy Eucharist*.

At the *Altar of Sacrifice*, the *priest* lays down his life and the *sacred assembly* does likewise. This is our mutual *fiat* – our *yes* spoken and offered in thanksgiving that the Lord receive us as a people in need of redemption. The Lord indeed comes to us with redeeming grace. Together, priest and people offer themselves in Christ and through Christ to the Father. Ours is a plea that God make all things new and keep us on the narrow, but difficult path that serves humanity even as it carries us to the homeland. Our turning *Ad Orientem* facilitates a proper response to having been fed with the *Word of God* as well as an appropriate preparation for the *Supper of the Lamb*.

WE OFFER TWO OPTIONS FOR THE RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION:

After the Second Vatican Council, standing for reception of the *Holy Eucharist* became the norm and fits the directives of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. Nonetheless, kneeling to receive Jesus in *Holy Communion* is in keeping with the enduring tradition of our ancestors. Today the option to kneel or stand rests with the individual. Likewise, the option to receive the *Holy Eucharist* on the tongue or on the hand rests with the individual.

Whichever manner we choose to receive Jesus in the *Holy Eucharist*, let us be conscious of this sacred and life sustaining encounter. Let us receive Him in grace and with gratitude, humbly and in humility.

Salaries	\$142,920	\$11,910	\$2,748	Salaries of staff: pastor, operations director for church/school, secretary, CCD director, 2 organists, accounting assistant. We save money because we have 1 priest serving entire parish in 3 languages, share operations director 50% of time with another parish, have only 2 full-time staff (pastor/secretary), do not have any maintenance staff. Church cleaning/maintenance done volunteered.
Health Insurance	\$25,920	\$2,160	\$498	Health insurance of pastor, 50% of operations director, secretary.
Employer FICA	\$7,491	\$624	\$144	Federally required employment taxes that must be paid.
Fringe Benefits	\$8,060	\$672	\$155	Employee pension, basic life insurance, social security benefits.
Ministry	\$2,000	\$167	\$38	Support of various church ministries.
Books & Supplies	\$5,000	\$417	\$96	Bulletin printing, offertory envelope printing, CCD books.
Administrative Expenses	\$15,000	\$1,250	\$288	Church database software, postage, payment processing, payroll processing, Brink's secure transportation, copy machine, service fees.
Transportation	\$3,600	\$300	\$69	Priest vehicle lease and vehicle repair.
Food Service & Meals	\$6,000	\$500	\$115	Priest meal allowance.
Telephone	\$3,700	\$308	\$71	Cost of landline and cell phone service, line charges, internet.
Heating Fuel	\$40,000	\$3,333	\$769	Cost for heating church/rectory. In very cold winters, this can increase annual cost up to \$50,000. Note this is higher cost than in most parishes since we are open all day and night.
Electricity	\$20,000	\$1,667	\$385	Cost of electricity to light church and rectory. Note this is higher than in most parishes since we are open all day and night so church lights are on all night.
Other Utilities	\$4,000	\$333	\$77	Garbage pick-up. This used to be a free service to all churches but now the city requires parish to pay a private garbage company for garbage disposal.
Maintenance	\$10,000	\$833	\$192	We keep our maintenance costs to a minimum but we still need to buy cleaning supplies, pay for snow removal & salting of parking lots (average \$4000/year), emergency heat company calls, sewer rodding, organ tuning, minor repairs.
Adoration Security	\$45,260	\$3,772	\$870	Keeping the church open 24/7 has security costs associated with it. We have security at night to keep our sanctuary safe for Adorers. This is an expense that is integral to our mission. Atlas Security has generously donated \$6,000 of security hours to help us offset this cost.
