LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we approach the penitential season of Lent let us take advantage of this opportunity to put aside societal and Church issues that bother us and use the holy season as an opportunity to be renewed in Christ. Selfishness and self-centeredness along with gross and perverse deviations from the moral code of our faith as well as a propensity to power grabs and agendas to promote self-interests have created angst and divisions which run rampant in this era of ours.

Angst and divisions are too often sad realities in our homes, nation, and in the *Holy Church*. We would be hard pressed to deny this. Less fixation on the barrage of bad news and more attention to Christ would bring some healthy perspective to the challenges we face in our daily lives. Less preoccupation on the passing *things* of this world to fill the void of our lives and renewed desire to be formed by Christ would satisfy our need for a sense of interior well-being. We need only create the space and set out in search of Jesus who is always closer to us than we are to ourselves.

As happens in history by God's benevolence, where sin abounds grace is all the more made manifest. If we would only dare to be disposed and receptive, the Lord will work wonders in our personal lives and in the life of the Church – wonders that ripple through the ugliness to reopen our eyes and those of others to beauty. We must not allow ourselves to be so consumed by evil that we become blind to the good or so weighed down by darkness that the light is eclipsed.

To perceive the beauty, the good, the light, and the truth requires of us an active passivity. In other words we need to find rest in the Lord. We must actively set out to be *still in the Lord*. Jesus will then move us into action ever conscious that He is with us as we go about the arduous work of life in the midst of a *perverse and depraved generation* as sacred scripture reminds us. Christians who live the faith prayerfully, sincerely, and deeply illumine the way out of perversity and depravity.

By God's grace, very much like the *Holy Eucharist* we adore and consume, in a hidden and quiet way, we bring a peace that confounds the wise of this world. For this reason I ask that during Lent we all set out to discover anew the sublime mystery of our Catholic faith, that is, Jesus ever present to us in the *Holy Eucharist*. Let us come to Mass in search of Jesus and let us go to Him in adoration with the Biblical disposition that summons: *Be still and know that I am God*. And our response: *Speak Lord your servant listens*.

My friends if we do not approach the *Holy Eucharist* in such a manner we are not quite disposed and our actions supersede those of Christ Jesus. His sanctifying grace is blocked if we are not receptive. Our labors are then wrought with anxiety and frustration that we are unable to *move the mountains*.

Remember He is the *potter* and we are the *clay*. Our presence before the Lord in the *Holy Eucharist* should be likened to *clay* in the hand of the *potter*. In other words we should be pliable, allowing Him to mold us according to His will. Truth to be told, if we are truly disposed, He fashions us into His own image and likeness. There is nothing more beautiful than this. Indeed this is the work of a lifetime and requires patient perseverance on our part. But all the while even hidden to you and me His work in our lives is perceived by others. That's the good news and that's what brings hope to others.

CARTA DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Hermanos y Hermanas en Cristo,

Mientras que nos acercamos al tiempo penitencionario de la Cuaresma, aprovechemos esta oportunidad de hacer a un lado cuestiones sociales y de la Iglesia las cuales nos molestan y usemos esta temporada santa como una oportunidad de ser renovados en Cristo. El egoísmo junto con las desviaciones perversas contra el código moral de nuestra fe al igual la tendencia al poder, nos agarran y las agendas de promover intereses personales han creado una angustia y divisiones las cuales corren desenfrenadamente en nuestros tiempos.

La angustia y las divisiones a menudo son la triste realidad en nuestros hogares, nación, y en la *Santa Iglesia*. Seríamos tercos en negar esto. Prestemos menos atención sobre el bombardeo de malas noticias y más atención a Cristo quien nos traería una perspectiva sana a los desafíos que enfrentamos en nuestras vidas del diario. El prestare menos atención a las cosas pasajeras de este mundo para llenar el vacío de nuestras vidas y el renovar nuestro deseo de ser formados por Cristo satisfaría nuestra necesidad de un sentir del bienestar del interior. Solamente tenemos que crear el espacio e ir en búsqueda de Jesús quien está más cerca de nosotros que nosotros mismos.

Como suele suceder en la historia a través de la bondad de Dios, donde abunda el pecado la gracia se manifiesta aún más. Tan solo si fuéramos valientes de estar dispuestos y abiertos, el Señor trabajará maravillas en nuestras vidas personales y en la fe de la Iglesia – maravillas que rompen lo feo para así abrir de nuevo nuestros ojos y los ojos de los demás a la belleza. No debemos permitir ser consumidos por la maldad hasta al punto que nos volvemos ciegos a lo bueno o dejarnos llevar por la obscuridad hasta el punto que la luz es eclipsada.

Para percibir, lo bueno, la luz, y la verdad requiere de nosotros una pasividad activa. En otras palabras, necesitamos encontrar el descanso en el Señor. Debemos activamente buscar la *tranquilidad en el Señor*. Entonces Jesús nos moverá a la acción haciéndonos conscientes de que Él está con nosotros mientras que nos encontramos en el trabajo duro de la vida en medio de una *perversa y depravada generación*. Los cristianos que viven la fe en oración, con sinceridad, y profundamente iluminan el camino fuera de la perversidad y la depravación.

Por gracia de Dios, tanto como la *Sagrada Eucaristía* que adoramos y consumimos, de una manera oculta y silenciosa, traemos una paz que sorprende a los sabios de este mundo. Por esta razón pido que durante la Cuaresma tratemos de descubrir de nuevo el misterio sublime de nuestra fe católica, o sea, Jesús más que nunca presente a nosotros en la *Sagrada Eucaristía*. Vengamos a Misa en búsqueda de Jesús y vayamos a Él en adoración con la disposición Bíblica que nos llama: *Manténganse quietos y sepan que soy Dios*. Y nuestra respuesta: *Habla Señor que tu siervo escucha*.

Amigos míos, si no nos acercamos a la *Sagrada Eucaristía* de tal manera no estamos dispuestos y nuestros actos van más allá que los de Cristo Jesús. Su gracia santificadora es obstruida si no estamos abiertos. Nuestras labores están forjadas con ansiedad y frustración que no podemos *mover las montañas*.

Recuerden Él es el *alfarero* y nosotros somos el *barro*. Nuestra presencia ante el Señor en la *Sagrada Eucaristía* debe ser comparada al *barro* en manos del *alfarero*. En otras palabras, debemos ser dóciles, permitiéndolo moldearnos de acuerdo a Su voluntad. La verdad es que, si estamos verdaderamente abiertos, Él nos forma en su propia imagen y semejanza. No hay nada más bello que esto. En verdad, esto es un trabajo de toda la vida y requiere una perseverancia paciente de nuestra parte. Pero en todo ese tiempo se mantiene oculto ante ti y ante mí y Su trabajo en nuestras vidas es percibido por los demás. Esa es la buena noticia y eso es lo que le trae la esperanza a los demás.

HOW WE PRAY AT ST. STANISLAUS KOSTKA

WE KEEP OUR DOORS OPEN ALL DAY AND ALL NIGHT:

We listen. In response to the call of the Blessed Virgin Mary we strive to create quiet refuge from the labor of life's journey where the soul is opened to the transforming power of God's ever abiding presence. The grace of the *Holy Eucharist* will assist a covenant people on its return to childlike trust in Jesus, provide healing and strength, and inspire enthusiasm for the work of life. Therefore we wish to safeguard sacred silence in this sanctuary that God's voice is heard in the deep recesses of the soul.

WE OFFER THE SACRED MYSTERIES AD ORIENTEM:

The *Sacred Mysteries* are offered as they were for nearly 2000 years. Today, while the *ordinary form* for offering the *Holy Eucharist* has the priest facing the *sacred assembly*, here we follow an ancient form of the *Holy Offering*, the priest and the people together, raising their eyes to the *East* from where the Lord will come at the end of all things.

This option for offering the *Sacred Mysteries* was nearly universally eclipsed in the aftermath of the Second Vatican Council beginning in the mid-1960s, but Pope Benedict, Cardinal Sarah, and other Church Fathers have inspired a resurgence of this ancient gesture for offering the *Liturgy of the Holy Eucharist*.

At the *Altar of Sacrifice*, the *priest* lays down his life and the *sacred assembly* does likewise. This is our mutual *fiat* – our *yes* spoken and offered in thanksgiving that the Lord receive us as a people in need of redemption. The Lord indeed comes to us with redeeming grace. Together, priest and people offer themselves in Christ and through Christ to the Father. Ours is a plea that God make all things new and keep us on the narrow, but difficult path that serves humanity even as it carries us to the homeland. Our turning *Ad Orientem* facilitates a proper response to having been fed with the *Word of God* as well as an appropriate preparation for the *Supper of the Lamb*.

WE OFFER TWO OPTIONS FOR THE RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION:

After the Second Vatican Council, standing for reception of the *Holy Eucharist* became the norm and fits the directives of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. Nonetheless, kneeling to receive Jesus in *Holy Communion* is in keeping with the enduring tradition of our ancestors. Today the option to kneel or stand rests with the individual. Likewise, the option to receive the *Holy Eucharist* on the tongue or on the hand rests with the individual.

Whichever manner we choose to receive Jesus in the *Holy Eucharist*, let us be conscious of this sacred and life sustaining encounter. Let us receive Him in grace and with gratitude, humbly and in humility.

Salaries	\$142,920	\$11,910	\$2,748	Salaries of staff: pastor, operations director for church/school, secretary, CCD director, 2 organists, accounting assistant. We save money because we have 1 priest serving entire parish in 3 languages, share operations director 50% of time with another parish, have only 2 full-time staff (pastor/secretary), do not have any maintenance staff. Church cleaning/maintenance done volunteered.
Health Insurance	\$25,920	\$2,160	\$498	Health insurance of pastor, 50% of operations director, secretary.
Employer FICA	\$7,491	\$624	\$144	Federally required employment taxes that must be paid.
Fringe Benefits	\$8,060	\$672	\$155	Employee pension, basic life insurance, social security benefits.
Ministry	\$2,000	\$167	\$38	Support of various church ministries.
Books & Supplies	\$5,000	\$417	\$96	Bulletin printing, offertory envelope printing, CCD books.
Administrative Expenses	\$15,000	\$1,250	\$288	Church database software, postage, payment processing, payroll processing, Brink's secure transportation, copy machine, service fees.
Transportation	\$3,600	\$300	\$69	Priest vehicle lease and vehicle repair.
Food Service & Meals	\$6,000	\$500	\$115	Priest meal allowance.
Telephone	\$3,700	\$308	\$71	Cost of landline and cell phone service, line charges, internet.
Heating Fuel	\$40,000	\$3,333	\$769	Cost for heating church/rectory. In very cold winters, this can increase annual cost up to \$50,000. Note this is higher cost than in most parishes since we are open all day and night.
Electricity	\$20,000	\$1,667	\$385	Cost of electricity to light church and rectory. Note this is higher than in most parishes since we are open all day and night so church lights are on all night.
Other Utilities	\$4,000	\$333	\$77	Garbage pick-up. This used to be a free service to all churches but now the city requires parish to pay a private garbage company for garbage disposal.
Maintenance	\$10,000	\$833	\$192	We keep our maintenance costs to a minimum but we still need to buy cleaning supplies, pay for snow removal & salting of parking lots (average \$4000/year), emergency heat company calls, sewer rodding, organ tuning, minor repairs.
Adoration Security	\$45,260	\$3,772	\$870	Keeping the church open 24/7 has security costs associated with it. We have security at night to keep our sanctuary safe for Adorers. This is an expense that is integral to our mission. Atlas Security has generously donated \$6,000 of security hours to help us offset this cost.
Altar & Liturgical Supply	\$21,000	\$1,750	\$404	Hosts/wine, votive/vigil lights, candles, missalette/liturgical publications, flowers
Archdiocesan Assessment	\$50,000	\$4,167	\$962	Each parish pays an annual assessment for Archdiocesan programs.
