Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

With this letter I write to you about a development that should disturb us greatly, both as citizens and as disciples of Jesus, the Lord of life.

Recently, two bills have been introduced in the Illinois House and Senate. The first, House Bill 2495 and Senate Bill 1942, both identical pieces of legislation, seeks to strip unborn persons of any protection – or even consideration – under the law and declare abortion to be a “fundamental right” and matter of health care. The end result is that an abortion could be obtained at any stage of pregnancy, including late term, for any reason and without any regulation. The law would no longer guarantee any modicum of humanity or compassion for any unborn person in Illinois, even if they are partially born. This legislation also repeals the Abortion Performance Refusal Act, which protects doctors, nurses and hospitals who refuse to permit, recommend, perform or assist in abortion. In so doing, rights of conscience, especially religious objections, will be lost.


The second piece of legislation House Bill 2467 and its identical Senate Bill 1594, repeals the Illinois Parental Notice of Abortion Act. This law, upheld unanimously by the Illinois Supreme Court just six years ago, has the common-sense purpose of ensuring that parents would be part of the life-altering decision of their minor child in the case she seeks an abortion. This effective law has reduced abortions performed on minors by fifty-seven percent.

As citizens of a state and people of faith who care about the common good, I urge you to join me and my brother bishops in an effort to defeat this radical departure from current law and practice in our state. Please reach out your State Representative and Senator to urge defeat of these bills.

Estimadas hermanas y hermanos en Cristo,

Con esta carta les escribo acerca de una novedad que nos debe perturbar grandemente, como ciudadanos tanto como discípulos de Jesús, el Señor de la Vida.

Recientemente, dos proyectos de ley han sido introducidos en la Cámara de Representantes y el Senado de Illinois. El primero, el Proyecto de ley de la Cámara 2495 y el Proyecto de ley del Senado 1942, ambas piezas de legislación idénticas, busca despojar a personas que no han nacido de cualquier protección —o incluso consideración— bajo la ley y declarar al aborto un "derecho fundamental" y un asunto del cuidado de la salud. El resultado final es que un aborto podría ser obtenido en cualquier etapa del embarazo, incluyendo la última etapa, por cualquier razón y sin ninguna regulación. La ley ya no garantizaría un mínimo de humanidad o compasión hacia cualquier persona por nacer en Illinois, incluso si han nacido parcialmente. Esta legislación también revoca la ley Abortion Performance Refusal Act (Ley de Rechazo de Realización de Aborto), que protege a doctores, enfermeras y hospitales que se niegan a permitir, recomendar, realizar o asistir en un aborto. Al hacerlo, los derechos de conciencia, especialmente las objeciones religiosas, se perderán.

La segunda pieza de legislación, Proyecto de Ley de la Cámara 2467 y su idéntico Proyecto de ley del Senado 1594, revocaría la ley Illinois Parental Notice of Abortion Act (Ley de Notificación de Aborto a Padres de Illinois). Esta ley, confirmada por unanimidad por la Corte Suprema de Illinois hace apenas seis años, tienen el propósito del sentido común de garantizar que los padres serían parte de la decisión que altera la vida de su hija menor de edad en caso de que ella busque un aborto. Esta ley efectiva ha reducido los abortos realizados en menores en un cincuenta y siete por ciento.

Como ciudadanos de un estado y personas de fe que se preocupan por el bien común, los insto a que se unan a mí y a mis hermanos obispos en un esfuerzo por derrotar esta salida radical de la ley y práctica actual en nuestro estado. Por favor comuníquense con su senador y representante estatal para instar a derrotar estos proyectos de ley. Drogie Siostry i Drodzy Bracia w Chrystusie,

Kieruję do Was te słowa o zmianach, które powinny głęboko zaniepokoić nas, jako obywateli i jako uczniów Jezusa, Pana życia.


Ostatnio wprowadzono dwie propozycje ustaw w Senacie Stanu Illinois. Pierwsza znana jest jako House Bill 2495, druga jaką jest ustawa w Senacie, to Bill 1942. Obie są identycznymi aktami prawnymi, które mają na celu pozbawienie nienarodzonych dzieci wszelkiej ochrony - a nawet rozważają w zgodzie z prawem - uznanie aborcji za „podstawowe prawo” i kwestię opieki zdrowotnej. Konsekwencją wprowadzenia tych ustaw jest to, że aborcję będzie można dokonać w dowolnym etapie ciąży, włączwszy późny okres z jakiegokolwiek powodu i bez jakichkolwiek regulacji. Prawo nie będzie już dłużej gwarantować choćby odrobiny szacunku ludzkiego lub współczucia jakimkolwiek nienarodzonemu dziecku w stanie Illinois, nawet jeśli dzieci te są już częściowo urodzone. Przepisy te uchylają również ustawę o odmowie wykonania aborcji, która chroni lekarzy, pielęgniarki i szpitale odmawiające zezwolenia, dania rekomendacji, dokonania aborcji lub asystowania podczas aborcji. Jeśli ustawa ta zostanie wprowadzona, prawo wolności sumienia, szczególnie odwołujące się do pobudek religijnych, zostanie utracone.

Drugi akt prawny House Bill 2467 i jego identyczna Ustawa Senacka 1594, uchylą ustawę Informowania Rodziców o Aborcji (Illinois Parental Notice of Abortion Act). Celem tej zdroworozsądkowej ustawy przegłosowanej jednomyślnie przez Sąd Najwyższy Stanu Illinois zaledwie sześć lat temu, jest zapewnienie, by rodzice osoby nieletniej usiłującej dokonać aborcji, wraz z nią podejmowali tę życiową decyzję. To skuteczne prawo ograniczyło o pięćdziesiąt siedem procent aborcje dokonywane przez nieletnich.

Apeluję do Was, jako obywateli naszego stanu i ludzi wiary, którzy troszczą się o dobro wspólne, abyście dołączyli do mnie i moich braci biskupów i pomogli zniweczyć zamiary tej radykalnej zmiany naszego obecnego prawa i praktyk w naszym stanie. Proszę skontaktuj się ze swoim reprezentantem stanowym i stanowym senatorem, aby nakłonić ich do odrzucenia tej propozycji ustawy. Prayers, Devotions, and Confession

Divine Mercy Chaplet: 3:00 p.m. – Monday thru Friday beginning March 6 through April 17

Adoration: Commit to Adoration before the Blessed Sacrament at the Monstrance Our Lady of the Sign. The church/sanctuary is open 24/7. Sign up in the vestibule.

Confessions: 5:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. – Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday. (The weeks when Fr. Anthony is in Rochester at the Mayo Clinic, confessions will be from 6:00 p.m. to 6:45 p.m. He is expected to be out the week of April 1st).

Mass: Monday through Friday at 7:00 p.m. and Saturday morning at 7:30 a.m.

Stations of the Cross: Friday evening immediately after the 7:00 p.m. Mass. (bi-lingual)

Study

Lenten Reflections: “The Eucharist” 5 session course Mondays 7:30 p.m. (after 7:00 p.m. Mass), OR Sundays 8:45 a.m. in the rectory. The sessions may be followed online beginning March 11th through April 8th. (see details in bulletin)

Penance

Fast/Abstinence: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 to 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Rite of the Church - binding on Roman Catholics from the age of 14 and older. (USCCB)

HOW WE PRAY AT ST. STANISLAUS KOSTKA

WE KEEP OUR DOORS OPEN ALL DAY AND ALL NIGHT:

We listen. In response to the call of the Blessed Virgin Mary we strive to create quiet refuge from the labor of life's journey where the soul is opened to the transforming power of God's ever abiding presence. The grace of the *Holy Eucharist* will assist a covenant people on its return to childlike trust in Jesus, provide healing and strength, and inspire enthusiasm for the work of life. Therefore we wish to safeguard sacred silence in this sanctuary that God's voice is heard in the deep recesses of the soul.

WE OFFER THE SACRED MYSTERIES AD ORIENTEM:

The *Sacred Mysteries* are offered as they were for nearly 2000 years. Today, while the *ordinary form* for offering the *Holy Eucharist* has the priest facing the *sacred assembly*, here we follow an ancient form of the *Holy Offering*, the priest and the people together, raising their eyes to the *East* from where the Lord will come at the end of all things.

This option for offering the *Sacred Mysteries* was nearly universally eclipsed in the aftermath of the Second Vatican Council beginning in the mid-1960s, but Pope Benedict, Cardinal Sarah, and other Church Fathers have inspired a resurgence of this ancient gesture for offering the *Liturgy of the Holy Eucharist*.

At the *Altar of Sacrifice*, the *priest* lays down his life and the *sacred assembly* does likewise. This is our mutual *fiat* – our *yes* spoken and offered in thanksgiving that the Lord receive us as a people in need of redemption. The Lord indeed comes to us with redeeming grace. Together, priest and people offer themselves in Christ and through Christ to the Father. Ours is a plea that God make all things new and keep us on the narrow, but difficult path that serves humanity even as it carries us to the homeland. Our turning *Ad Orientem* facilitates a proper response to having been fed with the *Word of God* as well as an appropriate preparation for the *Supper of the Lamb*.

WE OFFER TWO OPTIONS FOR THE RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION:

After the Second Vatican Council, standing for reception of the *Holy Eucharist* became the norm and fits the directives of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. Nonetheless, kneeling to receive Jesus in *Holy Communion* is in keeping with the enduring tradition of our ancestors. Today the option to kneel or stand rests with the individual. Likewise, the option to receive the *Holy Eucharist* on the tongue or on the hand rests with the individual.

Whichever manner we choose to receive Jesus in the *Holy Eucharist*, let us be conscious of this sacred and life sustaining encounter. Let us receive Him in grace and with gratitude, humbly and in humility.

PRAYER TO SAINT MICHAEL THE ARCHANGEL
