From the Confessions of St. Augustine, bishop – Fourth Century

O eternal truth, true love, and beloved eternity

Urged to reflect upon myself, I entered under your guidance into the inmost depth of my soul. I was able to do so because *you were my helper*. On entering into myself I saw, as it were with the eye of the soul, what was beyond the eye of the soul, beyond my spirit: your immutable light. It was not the ordinary light perceptible to all flesh, nor was it merely something of greater magnitude but still essentially akin, shining more clearly and diffusing itself everywhere by its intensity. No, it was something entirely distinct, something altogether different from all these things; and it did not rest above my mind as oil on the surface of water, nor was it above me as heaven is above the earth. This light was above me because it had made me; I was below it because I was created by it. He who has come to know the truth knows this light.

O Eternal truth, true love and beloved eternity. You are my God. To you do I sigh day and night. When I first came to know you, you drew me to yourself so that I might see that there were things for me to see, but that I myself was not yet ready to see them. Meanwhile you overcame the weakness of my vision, sending forth most strongly the beams of your light, and I trembled at once with love and dread. I learned that I was in a region unlike yours and far distant from you, and I thought I heard your voice from on high: “I am the food of grown men; grow then, and you will feed on me. Nor will you change me into yourself like bodily food, but you will be changed into me.”

I sought a way to gain the strength which I needed to enjoy you. But I did not find it until I embraced *the mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, who is above all, God blessed forever*. He was calling me and saying: *I am the way of truth, I am the life*. He was offering the food which I lacked the strength to take, the food he had mingled with our flesh. For *the Word became flesh*, that your wisdom, by which you created all things, might provide milk for us children.

Late have I loved you, O Beauty ever ancient, ever new, late have I loved you! You were within me, but I was outside, and it was there that I searched for you. In my unloveliness I plunged into the lovely things which you created. You were with me, but I was not with you. Created things kept me from you; yet if they had not been in you they would not have been at all. You called, you shouted, and you broke through my deafness. You flashed, you shone, and you dispelled my blindness. You breathed your fragrance on me; I drew in breath and now I pant for you. I have tasted you, now I hunger and thirst for more. You touched me, and I burned for your peace.

DE LAS CONFESIONES DE SAN AGUSTÍN, OBISPO – CUARTO SIGLO

¡OH ETERNA VERDAD, VERDADERA CARIDAD Y CARA ETERNIDAD!

Habiéndome convencido de que debía volver a mí mismo, penetré en mi interior, siendo tú mi guía, y ello me fue posible porque tú, *Señor, me socorriste*. Entré y vi con los ojos de mi alma, de un modo u otro, por encima de la capacidad de estos mismos ojos, por encima de mi mente, una luz inmutable; no esta luz ordinaria y visible a cualquier hombre, por intensa y clara que fuese y que lo llenara todo con su magnitud. Se trataba de una luz completamente distinta. Ni estaba por encima de mi mente, como el aceite sobre el agua o como el cielo sobre la tierra, sino que estaba en lo más alto, ya que ella fue quien me hizo, y yo estaba en lo más bajo, porque fue hecho por ella. La conoce el que conoce la verdad. ¡Oh eterna verdad, verdadera caridad y cara eternidad! Tú eres mi Dios, por ti suspiro día y noche. Y, cuando te conocí por vez primera, fuiste tú quien me elevó hacia ti, para hacerme ver que había algo que ver y que yo no era aún capaz de verlo. Y fortaleciste la debilidad de mi mirada irradiando con fuerza sobre mí, de la gran distancia que me separaba de ti, por la gran semejanza que hay entre tú y yo, como si oyera tu voz que me decía desde arriba: Soy alimento de adultos: crece, y podrás comerme. Y no me transformarás en sustancia tuya, como sucede con la comida corporal, sino que tú te transformarás en mí.

Y yo buscaba el camino para adquirir un vigor que me hiciera capaz de gozar de ti, y no lo encontraba, hasta que me abracé al *mediador entre Dios y los hombres, Cristo Jesús, hombre también él, el cual está por encima de todas las cosas, Dios bendito por los siglos*, que me llamaba y me decía: *Yo soy el camino de la verdad y la vida*, y el que mezcla aquel alimento, que yo no podía asimilar, con la carne, ya que *la Palabra se hizo carne*, para que, en atención a nuestro estado de infancia, se convirtiera en leche tu sabiduría, por la que creaste todas las cosas.

Tarde te amé, Hermosura tan antigua y tan nueva, tarde te amé y tú estabas dentro de mí y yo afuera, y así por fuera te buscaba; y, deforme como era, me lanzaba sobre estas cosas hermosas que tú creaste. Tú estabas conmigo, mas yo no estaba contigo. Reteníanme lejos de ti aquellas cosas que, si no estuviesen en ti, no existirían. Me llamaste y clamaste, y quebrantaste mi sordera; brillaste y resplandeciste, y curaste mi ceguera; exhalaste tu perfume y lo aspiré, y ahora te anhele; gusté de ti, y ahora siento hambre y sed de ti; me tocaste, y seseé con ansia la paz que procede de ti.

Divine Mercy Chaplet: 3:00 p.m. – Monday thru Friday beginning March 6 through April 17

Adoration: Commit to Adoration before the Blessed Sacrament at the Monstrance Our Lady of the Sign. The church/sanctuary is open 24/7. Sign up in the vestibule.

Confessions: 5:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. – Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday. (The weeks when Fr. Anthony is in Rochester at the Mayo Clinic, confessions will be from 6:00 p.m. to 6:45 p.m. He is expected to be out the week of April 1st).

Mass: Monday through Friday at 7:00 p.m. and Saturday morning at 7:30 a.m.

Stations of the Cross: Friday evening immediately after the 7:00 p.m. Mass. (bi-lingual)

Study

Lenten Reflections: “The Eucharist” 5 session course Mondays 7:30 p.m. (after 7:00 p.m. Mass), OR Sundays 8:45 a.m. in the rectory. The sessions may be followed online beginning March 11th through April 8th. (see details in bulletin)

Penance

Fast/Abstinence: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 to 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Rite of the Church - binding on Roman Catholics from the age of 14 and older. (USCCB)

House Bill (HB) 2495/ Senate Bill (SB) 1942 will result in the right to procure an abortion at any time without any regulation and will also terminate the right of medical providers to refuse to provide abortions event under religious grounds. HB 2467/SB1594 will repeal the requirement to notify parents of a minor child seeking an abortion.

HOW WE PRAY AT ST. STANISLAUS KOSTKA

WE KEEP OUR DOORS OPEN ALL DAY AND ALL NIGHT:

We listen. In response to the call of the Blessed Virgin Mary we strive to create quiet refuge from the labor of life's journey where the soul is opened to the transforming power of God's ever abiding presence. The grace of the *Holy Eucharist* will assist a covenant people on its return to childlike trust in Jesus, provide healing and strength, and inspire enthusiasm for the work of life. Therefore we wish to safeguard sacred silence in this sanctuary that God's voice is heard in the deep recesses of the soul.

WE OFFER THE SACRED MYSTERIES AD ORIENTEM:

The *Sacred Mysteries* are offered as they were for nearly 2000 years. Today, while the *ordinary form* for offering the *Holy Eucharist* has the priest facing the *sacred assembly*, here we follow an ancient form of the *Holy Offering*, the priest and the people together, raising their eyes to the *East* from where the Lord will come at the end of all things.

This option for offering the *Sacred Mysteries* was nearly universally eclipsed in the aftermath of the Second Vatican Council beginning in the mid-1960s, but Pope Benedict, Cardinal Sarah, and other Church Fathers have inspired a resurgence of this ancient gesture for offering the *Liturgy of the Holy Eucharist*.

At the *Altar of Sacrifice*, the *priest* lays down his life and the *sacred assembly* does likewise. This is our mutual *fiat* – our *yes* spoken and offered in thanksgiving that the Lord receive us as a people in need of redemption. The Lord indeed comes to us with redeeming grace. Together, priest and people offer themselves in Christ and through Christ to the Father. Ours is a plea that God make all things new and keep us on the narrow, but difficult path that serves humanity even as it carries us to the homeland. Our turning *Ad Orientem* facilitates a proper response to having been fed with the *Word of God* as well as an appropriate preparation for the *Supper of the Lamb*.

WE OFFER TWO OPTIONS FOR THE RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION:

After the Second Vatican Council, standing for reception of the *Holy Eucharist* became the norm and fits the directives of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. Nonetheless, kneeling to receive Jesus in *Holy Communion* is in keeping with the enduring tradition of our ancestors. Today the option to kneel or stand rests with the individual. Likewise, the option to receive the *Holy Eucharist* on the tongue or on the hand rests with the individual.

Whichever manner we choose to receive Jesus in the *Holy Eucharist*, let us be conscious of this sacred and life sustaining encounter. Let us receive Him in grace and with gratitude, humbly and in humility.
