LETTER FROM THE PASTOR
MOTHER'S DAY

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we celebrate Mother's Day we appropriately venerate and celebrate the Mother of us all, the Blessed Virgin Mary. In today's gospel Jesus speaks with great affection of the sheep who hear his voice and follow him. He promises they shall never perish. To them he promises eternal life.

Here at St. Stanislaus Kostka we are blessed that the Mother of God has deemed us worthy to receive her. She is sprinkling the world with sanctuaries because she knows the night is near and the day is far spent. As the great Marian pope, St. John Paul II, said in 1976, *the final confrontation between the Church and the anti-Church, the Gospel and the anti-Gospel, the Christ and the anti-Christ is upon us*. Sheep are being snatched from the fold.

When the Blessed Virgin Mary asked that the doors of St. Stanislaus Kostka be left open she expressed a motherly gesture to ensure that the sheep not be snatched from the fold of the Shepherd. Her invitation to open the doors of this parish is a plea to restore her children to their proper place in the family of God. She opens the doors to ensure that we will survive.

As the *Ancients of Old* survived in the time of great distress having been washed in the *Blood of the Lamb*, we too, in our time, survive the distresses of life through participation in the *Sacred Mysteries* of our faith and through contemplation of the *Holy Eucharist* at the *Ark of her Immaculate Heart*. We are lifted up and renewed in victory. We become a light to others and point to Christ and Our Lady, instruments of salvation to the ends of the earth.

The Mother of God, at the foot of the cross, was the altar upon which the Blood of Christ was spilled. She intimately and deeply participated in the redeeming death of her Son. In Mary, the prophetic utterances of Isaiah are fulfilled, *Mother Israel – Daughter Zion, in one moments time suffers the pain of labor and gives birth to children she never conceived*. And so, Jesus solidifies the family as from the cross he entrusts his mother to us and we to her. We are the *Mystical Body of Christ – the Family of God*. We are bound and sealed together by the *Blood of the Lamb* and to us a mission has been entrusted. Our mission is to keep the doors of this parish always open.

That we were asked to open these doors is proof that the Mother of us all is not frozen in the pages of Sacred Scripture. The Blessed Virgin Mary is ever alive to console her children, giving them refuge from the wiles of the *Evil One* and bringing them to right relationship with her Son who is the door to the Father.

On this Mother's Day, as we venerate and celebrate the Mother of us all, I invite you to be a *Patron of Our Lady*. Together we fulfill her request to St. Stanislaus Kostka and to each of us to keep these doors open. As long as the doors are open, in hidden and quiet ways, lives are changed, healings conferred, and strength provided for the arduous work of life. This is not only about salvation at the end of all things, this is about salvation in the here and now of our lives.

Finally, Happy Mother's Day to all mothers who by their very nature share a kindred spirit with the Mother of God. Their hearts are forever pierced with the sword of sorrow as they inherently suffer for their children. May their suffering not be surpassed by joy in the knowledge that the love they bear for their children is known by God and is a sure means to salvation and peace at the end of their days.

CARTA DEL PÁRROCO

DÍA DE LAS MADRES

Estimados Hermanos y Hermanas en Cristo,

Mientras celebramos el Día de las Madres veneramos y celebramos de una manera propia a la Madre de todos nosotros, la Santísima Virgen María. En el Evangelio de hoy Jesús habla con gran afecto sobre las ovejas que escuchan Su voz y lo siguen. Él promete que nunca perecerán. A ellos les prometió vida eterna.

Aquí en la Parroquia de San Estanislao Kostka somos bendecidos que la Madre de Dios nos ha considerado dignos a recibirla. Ella está rociando al mundo con santuarios porque ella sabe que la noche se aproxima y el día está lejos. Así como el gran papa Mariano, San Pablo II, dijo en 1976, *el enfrentamiento final entre la Iglesia y la anti-iglesia, el Evangelio y el anti-evangelio, el Cristo y el anti-cristo está sobre nosotros*. Hay ovejas que están siendo arrebatadas del rebaño.

Cuando la Santísima Virgen María pidió que las puertas de San Estanislao Kostka se dejarán abiertas ella expresó un gesto materno de asegurar que las ovejas no fueran arrebatadas del rebaño del Pastor. Su invitación de abrir las puertas de esta parroquia es una plegaria para restaurar sus hijos a su lugar propio en la familia de Dios. Ella abre las puertas para asegurar que sobreviviremos.

Así como los *Antepasados* sobrevivieron en el tiempo de la gran angustia después de haber sido lavados en la *Sangre del Cordero*, nosotros también, en nuestro tiempo, sobrevivimos las angustias de la vida a través de la participación en los *Sagrados Misterios* de nuestra fe y por medio de la contemplación de la *Sagrada Eucaristía en el Arca de su Inmaculado Corazón*. Somos alentados y renovados en la Victoria. Nos convertimos en luz para los demás y apuntamos hacia a Cristo y hacia Nuestra Señora, instrumentos de la salvación hasta al fin del mundo.

La Madre de Dios, al pie de la cruz, fue el altar por el cual la Sangre de Cristo fue derramado. Ella íntimamente y profundamente participó en la muerte redentora de su Hijo. Por medio de María, las palabras proféticas de Isaías fueron llevadas a cabo. *Madre Israel – Hija Zión, en un momento sufre el dolor de parto y da a luz a hijos que nunca concibió*. Y, por lo tanto, Jesús soldifica la familia ya que desde la cruz Él confía Su madre a nosotros y nosotros a ella. Somos el *Cuerpo Místico de Cristo – la Familia de Dios*. Somos atados y sellados juntos por medio de la *Sangre del Cordero* y sobre nosotros una misión ha sido encomendada. Nuestra misión es de mantener las puertas de la parroquia siempre abiertas.

El que se nos pidió que abriéramos las puertas es prueba de que nuestra Madre no se encuentra congelada en las páginas de las Sagradas Escrituras. La Santísima Virgen María está viva para consolar a sus hijos, dándoles refugio de las garras del *Maligno* y llevándolos a una relación correcta con su Hijo que es la puerta que nos lleva al Padre.

En este Día de las Madres, mientras que veneramos y celebramos la Madre de todos nosotros, los invito a que sean *Padrinos de Nuestra Señora*. Juntos llevaremos a cabo su plegaria a San Estanislao Kostka a cada uno de nosotros a mantener estas puertas abiertas. Mientras que las puertas se mantengan abiertas, en maneras ocultas y silenciosas, las vidas son transformadas, sanaciones se llevan a cabo, la fuerza es dada para la labor ardua de la vida. Esto no se trata de la salvación al final de todas las cosas, esto se trata de la salvación del aquí y del ahora de nuestras vidas.

Finalmente, Feliz Día de las Madres a todas las madres quienes por su propia naturaleza comparten un espíritu similar al de la Madre de Dios. Sus corazones son eternamente traspasados por la espada de dolor mientras sufren por sus hijos. Que sus sufrimientos no sean más fuertes que la alegría al saber que el amor que tienen por sus hijos es conocido por Dios y es una fuente segura de salvación y paz al final de sus días.

HOW WE PRAY AT ST. STANISLAUS KOSTKA

WE KEEP OUR DOORS OPEN ALL DAY AND ALL NIGHT:

We listen. In response to the call of the Blessed Virgin Mary we strive to create quiet refuge from the labor of life's journey where the soul is opened to the transforming power of God's ever abiding presence. The grace of the *Holy Eucharist* will assist a covenant people on its return to childlike trust in Jesus, provide healing and strength, and inspire enthusiasm for the work of life. Therefore we wish to safeguard sacred silence in this sanctuary that God's voice is heard in the deep recesses of the soul.

WE OFFER THE SACRED MYSTERIES AD ORIENTEM:

The *Sacred Mysteries* are offered as they were for nearly 2000 years. Today, while the *ordinary form* for offering the *Holy Eucharist* has the priest facing the *sacred assembly*, here we follow an ancient form of the *Holy Offering*, the priest and the people together, raising their eyes to the *East* from where the Lord will come at the end of all things.

This option for offering the *Sacred Mysteries* was nearly universally eclipsed in the aftermath of the Second Vatican Council beginning in the mid-1960s, but Pope Benedict, Cardinal Sarah, and other Church Fathers have inspired a resurgence of this ancient gesture for offering the *Liturgy of the Holy Eucharist*.

At the *Altar of Sacrifice*, the *priest* lays down his life and the *sacred assembly* does likewise. This is our mutual *fiat* – our *yes* spoken and offered in thanksgiving that the Lord receive us as a people in need of redemption. The Lord indeed comes to us with redeeming grace. Together, priest and people offer themselves in Christ and through Christ to the Father. Ours is a plea that God make all things new and keep us on the narrow, but difficult path that serves humanity even as it carries us to the homeland. Our turning *Ad Orientem* facilitates a proper response to having been fed with the *Word of God* as well as an appropriate preparation for the *Supper of the Lamb*.

WE OFFER TWO OPTIONS FOR THE RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION:

After the Second Vatican Council, standing for reception of the *Holy Eucharist* became the norm and fits the directives of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. Nonetheless, kneeling to receive Jesus in *Holy Communion* is in keeping with the enduring tradition of our ancestors. Today the option to kneel or stand rests with the individual. Likewise, the option to receive the *Holy Eucharist* on the tongue or on the hand rests with the individual.

Whichever manner we choose to receive Jesus in the *Holy Eucharist*, let us be conscious of this sacred and life sustaining encounter. Let us receive Him in grace and with gratitude, humbly and in humility.
