LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Pentecost Sunday 2018

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

First of all I wish to remind you that on the *Feast of Corpus Christi*, Sunday - June 3rd, we will combine the 8:45, 10:00, and 11:30 Masses into one Mass to begin at 9:30 a.m. followed by a *Eucharistic Procession* through the neighborhood. All other Sunday Masses will be celebrated at their regular time – 5:00 p.m. - Saturday, 7:30 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. on Sunday. Join us for this public manifestation of faith and invite family and friends for the Holy Mass and solemn procession.

As we've celebrated three separate Holy Communion it is my hope that our young people join us for the procession dressed as they were for their Holy Communion.

The *Feast of Corpus Christi* and the traditional procession through the streets are statements of faith that indeed the Lord remains with us in a wholly unique way, under the hidden guise of *Bread and Wine* – His precious *Body and Blood*. This sublime mystery should not shock anyone when you consider that God brought us into existence out of nothing. Surely He fulfills His promise that He remains with us as food for the journey that we not collapse as we go on our way.

While the mystery of the *Holy Eucharist* should not shock us, what indeed is shocking is the sudden decrease in Mass attendance. This is not only a reality here at St. Stanislaus Kostka, but a phenomenon all over and not just among Catholics. Denominational Christians and Jewish Synagogues are suffering a similar crisis. The radical secularization of society perpetrated by institutions of public education, the media, and pop culture have effectively desensitized the people of our age to the necessity of organized religion and the noble worship of Almighty God. To think that we have not contributed to the problem would be ingenuous, but I don't intend to go into this at this writing.

Suffice to say, today the Church brings an end to the *Easter Season* with the *Feast of Pentecost*. Pentecost was the day the Church was born as the Apostles in the company of the Blessed Virgin Mary, after nine days of prayer, received the gift of the Holy Spirit. We should marvel at the power from on high that transformed the disciples of Jesus into a people set apart for a holy enterprise that would envelop all the nations of the world.

This holy enterprise has endured the test of time and at the promise of the Lord will continue until He comes at the end of time. Jesus held nothing back in telling us the *way* of the Church is not easy and the discipline of the faith would be difficult save the grace of the Holy Spirit. If we do not submit to the Spirit of God we succumb quite easily to the reign of the flesh as St. Paul reminds us. Just look around to determine under whose spirit we live.

The fruits and gifts of the Holy Spirit are evident in our sensitivity to the *Commandments of God* and that our lives give witness in *Beatitude*, that is, *blessed* things. Do not be discouraged if you find yourself in conflict. St. Paul also wrote, *The Spirit helps us in our weakness, for we do not know how to pray as we ought, but the Spirit makes intercession for us with groanings that cannot be expressed in speech... The sufferings of the present are as nothing compared to the glory to be revealed in us.*

Finally the assurance we have that we are in the Lord and He in us is that we remain ever faithful to the *Sacred Mysteries* of our faith, that is, the *Holy Eucharist*. For this, the Lord gave us a *commandment* to keep holy the *Sabbath* and at the heart of the *Sabbath* is the *Holy Eucharist*. We should not succumb to society's indifference to this precept of our faith. For love of God and in gratitude for God's love of us we joyfully fulfill our obligation to receive Jesus in the *Holy Eucharist* that we not lose our sensitivity to all *blessed* things.

CARTA DEL PÁRRACO

Domingo de Pentecostés 2018

Estimados Hermanos y Hermanas en Cristo,

Primeramente, les quiero recordar que el día de la *Fiesta de Corpus Cristi*, domingo 3 de junio, combinaremos las Misas de las 8:45 AM, 10:00 AM, y 11:30 AM en una Misa, la cual comenzará a las 9:30 AM seguido por la *Procesión Eucarística* por el vecindario. Todas las demás Misas serán celebradas en su horario regular. – el sábado a las 5:00 PM, el domingo a las 7:30 AM y 5:30 PM. Acompañenos para esta manifestación pública de fe e inviten a su familia y amistades para la Santa Misa y procesión solemne.

Mediante celebramos tres Primeras Comuniones separadas, mi esperanza es que nuestra juventud nos pueda acompañar en la procesión vestidos como lo estaban para su Primera Comunión.

La *Fiesta de Corpus Cristi* y la procesión tradicional por las calles son declaraciones de fe y verdaderamente el Señor permanece con nosotros de una manera completa y única, bajo la forma oculta del *Pan y el Vino*. – Su preciosísimo *Cuerpo y Sangre*. Este misterio sublime no debe sorprender a nadie ya que Dios nos trajo a la existencia de la nada. Realmente Él cumple la promesa de que Él permanece con nosotros como alimento para la jornada y así no caer mientras vamos por nuestro camino.

Mientras el misterio de la *Sagrada Eucaristía* no debe de sorprendernos, lo que es realmente sorprendente es la disminución repentina en la asistencia en la Misa. Esta no es una sola realidad aquí en San Estanislao Kostka, pero un fenómeno por todas partes y no solamente entre los católicos. Cristianos de otras denominaciones y Sinagogas Judías están sufriendo una crisis similar. La secularización radical de la sociedad perpetuada por las instituciones de educación pública, los medios de comunicación, la cultura pop, han desensibilizado de una manera efectiva al pueblo de nuestra era hacia la organización religiosa y el culto noble de Dios Todopoderoso. Pensar que nosotros no contribuimos al problema sería ingenuo, pero no pretendo en este momento comenzar a escribir sobre esto.

Es suficiente decir, hoy la Iglesia trae a su fin la *Temporada Pascual* con la *Fiesta de Pentecostés*. Pentecostés fue el día en que los Apóstoles en compañía de la Santísima Virgen María, después de nueve días en oración, recibieron el don del Espíritu Santo. Debemos maravillarnos con el poder del más alto el cual transformó a los discípulos de Jesús hacia un pueblo apartado para una labor santa la cual envolvería a todas las naciones del mundo.

Esta labor ha perdurado la prueba del tiempo y la promesa del Señor continuará hasta que Él venga al final del tiempo. Jesús no contuvo nada al decirnos que el *camino* de la Iglesia no es fácil y la disciplina de la fe sería difícil sin la gracia del Espíritu Santo. Si no nos sometemos al Espíritu de Dios nos dejamos llevar fácilmente por el dominio de la carne, así como nos recuerda San Pablo. Nada más miren alrededor y determinen bajo cual espíritu vivimos.

Los frutos y dones del Espíritu Santo son evidente en nuestra sensibilidad a los *Mandamientos de Dios* y que nuestras vidas den testimonio en las *Bienaventuranzas*, o sea, cosas sagradas. No se desanimen si se encuentran en conflicto. San Pablo también escribió, *El Espíritu nos ayuda en nuestra debilidad, ya que no sabemos cómo orar como es debido, pero el Espíritu intercede por nosotros con gemidos que no pueden ser expresados en el habla. Los sufrimientos del presente no son nada en comparación a la gloria que será revelada en nosotros.*

Finalmente, la seguridad que tenemos que estamos en el Señor y Él en nosotros es que permanecemos fiel a los *Sagrados Misterios* de nuestra fe, es decir, la *Sagrada Eucaristía*. Para esto, el Señor nos dio un *mandamiento* de santificar el día *Domingo* y al corazón del *Domingo* está la *Sagrada Eucaristía*. No debemos dejarnos llevar por la indiferencia de la sociedad a este precepto de nuestra fe. Por amor a Dios y en gratitud por el amor de Dios con gozo cumplimos con nuestra obligación de recibir a Jesús en la *Sagrada Eucaristía* de no perder nuestra sensibilidad a todas las cosas *sagradas*.

Our current heating system is on the verge of collapse. It is operating well beyond its expected life cycle. The heat circulation pumps are in such bad shape that they can go out any minute which would leave the church without heat for weeks. We have rotting pipes, leaking valves, and old boilers.

We've met with multiple heating companies who have all advised us to replace the current cast iron boilers with fire-tube boilers. This will lower maintenance costs and our annual heating bill, saving the parish about \$27,000 annually, which serves our efforts to operate the parish with minimal expenditures.

The complete replacement of the church and rectory's heating system will cost \$175,658. We have just been approved for a major rebate from People's Gas which brought the cost of the project down from \$225,000. This project will cover the entire replacement of the heating system and include upgrading every aspect of the church and rectory heating infrastructure which has not been done in many decades.

HOW WE PRAY AT ST. STANISLAUS KOSTKA

WE KEEP OUR DOORS OPEN ALL DAY AND ALL NIGHT:

We listen. In response to the call of the Blessed Virgin Mary we strive to create quiet refuge from the labor of life's journey where the soul is opened to the transforming power of God's ever abiding presence. The grace of the *Holy Eucharist* will assist a covenant people on its return to childlike trust in Jesus, provide healing and strength, and inspire enthusiasm for the work of life. Therefore we wish to safeguard sacred silence in this sanctuary that God's voice is heard in the deep recesses of the soul.

WE OFFER THE SACRED MYSTERIES AD ORIENTEM:

The *Sacred Mysteries* are offered as they were for nearly 2000 years. Today, while the *ordinary form* for offering the *Holy Eucharist* has the priest facing the *sacred assembly*, here we follow an ancient form of the *Holy Offering*, the priest and the people together, raising their eyes to the *East* from where the Lord will come at the end of all things.

This option for offering the *Sacred Mysteries* was nearly universally eclipsed in the aftermath of the Second Vatican Council beginning in the mid-1960s, but Pope Benedict, Cardinal Sarah, and other Church Fathers have inspired a resurgence of this ancient gesture for offering the *Liturgy of the Holy Eucharist*.

At the *Altar of Sacrifice*, the *priest* lays down his life and the *sacred assembly* does likewise. This is our mutual *fiat* – our *yes* spoken and offered in thanksgiving that the Lord receive us as a people in need of redemption. The Lord indeed comes to us with redeeming grace. Together, priest and people offer themselves in Christ and through Christ to the Father. Ours is a plea that God make all things new and keep us on the narrow, but difficult path that serves humanity even as it carries us to the homeland. Our turning *Ad Orientem* facilitates a proper response to having been fed with the *Word of God* as well as an appropriate preparation for the *Supper of the Lamb*.

WE OFFER TWO OPTIONS FOR THE RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION:

After the Second Vatican Council, standing for reception of the *Holy Eucharist* became the norm and fits the directives of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. Nonetheless, kneeling to receive Jesus in *Holy Communion* is in keeping with the enduring tradition of our ancestors. Today the option to kneel or stand rests with the individual. Likewise, the option to receive the *Holy Eucharist* on the tongue or on the hand rests with the individual.

Whichever manner we choose to receive Jesus in the *Holy Eucharist*, let us be conscious of this sacred and life sustaining encounter. Let us receive Him in grace and with gratitude, humbly and in humility.

This supports the Archdiocesan Pastoral Center which provides savings & loan services to parishes; administers employee benefits, property & casualty insurance program; provides financial support to those parishes unable to sustain themselves; operates a seminary system for the education of priests; provides nutritional lunch & breakfast program for students; publishes a newspaper & various liturgical-related publications; invests available funds. St Stan's has been a huge beneficiary of the Archdiocese's generosity.
PRMAA Assessment	\$8,300	\$692	\$160	Each parish pays an annual PRMAA assessment. The Priests' Retirement and Mutual Aid Association administers retirement, disability, health, other benefits for the priests of the Archdiocese.
Property/Casualty Insurance	\$50,000	\$4,167	\$962	Each parish pays an annual property insurance premium to the Archdiocese for coverage. Property casualty risks of the parish are covered by a self-insurance program administered through the Archdiocese.
Miscellaneous	\$5,000	\$417	\$96	Other charges incurred by the parish such as cost of advertising, religious ad book purchases, hosting meetings, banners, flyers, input costs of fundraisers.
