LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Scripture readings this 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time remind us that we are moving toward a cosmic upheaval. It'll be a time of unsurpassed distress which will culminate in the separation of the righteous from the unrighteous, the wise from the fools, and the good ones from the evil ones. For those who sincerely profess faith in God and strive to live that faith, all will end well. For those who knowingly reject God and choose themselves over God and others, their end will be *everlasting horror and disgrace* as today's Scripture warns.

It is the will of God that all be saved. For this reason the Father sent his only begotten Son to atone for sins. God spared Himself nothing of what we suffer and God will give to each one sufficient grace for conversion and salvation. However God cannot force anyone to receive what he or she does not want. In the end it is not God who separates Himself from man, but man who definitively separates himself from God.

Jesus tells us the end of time will be characterized by great tribulation and distress. Is there ever a time when we are spared tribulation and distress? Often we need only to look into our personal lives or the lives of our families to know that this is already a reality. The truth to be told, much distress would be mitigated if we'd only make the effort to set things right with God. But when society turns away from God, the tribulation and distress intensifies. How hard to make the effort to form the family when so much around us justifies a way of thinking and living that is radically opposed to the will of God. I suppose that's why Jesus calls the path to eternal life a narrow one. We persevere down that path only by the grace of God.

We are passing through unsettling times and great upheavals. The world totters on the precipice of mutual and cosmic destruction. The Lord is calling Christians to radical discipleship to counter the blows of nefarious forces pressing in. At a time like this the Church's credibility is threatened by a reluctance to proclaim the full counsel of God. Who can relate to a Church that sanitizes the teachings and the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus? Such a tendency only makes the Church irrelevant. Even in view of the Church's internal crisis we still have a tendency to think befriending the world at the expense of truth will gain us the world's respect. Jesus said the opposite. The world will always be at enmity with the Church.

Those soundbites of *love* used to justify human behavior that counters the commandments of God have been perverted at the expense of our future well-being. This only accelerates the impending cosmic upheaval spoken about in today's Scripture. Unapologetically Christians must humbly and mercifully embrace the commandment to *love* in the full meaning of the word. In imitation of Christ Jesus we live for love of the Father that our sacrifices for love of Him bear fruit in salvation for those we love and for those we do not love as we should. As Jesus said, *There is no greater love than that we lay down our lives for our friends.*

Scripture teaches clearly that in the end the powers of heaven will be shaken. This is inevitable. Before Christ's second coming the Church must pass through a final trial that will shake the faith of many believers, but the mystery of iniquity will be unveiled and in the end, all will see the Son of Man coming with great power and glory to claim what is His and the Kingdom will be fulfilled. Let us pray for the grace of final perseverance that at the end of all things we be counted among the wise who shall shine brightly like the stars forever and ever.

CARTA DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Hermanos y Hermanas en Cristo,

Las lecturas de las Escrituras del Trigésimo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario nos recuerdan que estamos moviéndonos hacia una conmoción cósmica. Será un tiempo de muchísimo estrés el cual culminará en la separación de los justos y los injustos, los sabios y los tontos, y los buenos de los malvados. Para aquellos que profesan sinceramente fe en Dios y se esfuerzan a vivir en fe, sus vidas tendrán un buen final. Para aquellos que rechazan a Dios y se escogen a sí mismos sobre Dios y los demás, su final será un horror eterno y desgracia como las Sagradas Escrituras de hoy nos advierten.

Es la voluntad de Dios que todos seamos salvos. Por esta razón Dios mandó su Hijo unigénito en expiación por nuestros pecados – una manifestación del Amor de Dios que nos debe convencer de tal hecho. Dios no se escatimo a Sí mismo de lo que sufrimos y Dios nos dará la gracia suficiente para la conversión y salvación. Sin embargo, Dios no puede forzar a nadie a recibir lo que él o ella no quiere. Al final no es Dios quien se separa del hombre, pero el hombre quien definitivamente se separa de Dios.

Jesús nos dice que el final de los tiempos será caracterizado por la gran tribulación y estrés. ¿A caso hay algún tiempo cuando nos escapamos de la tribulación y el estrés? A menudo sólo debemos mirar nuestras propias vidas o las vidas de nuestras familias para saber que esta ya es una realidad. La verdad que se debe decir, también sabemos que no es necesario el caso si tan sólo hacemos el intento de arreglar las cosas con Dios. Pero cuando la sociedad se aparta de Dios, la tribulación y la angustia se intensifican. Es tan difícil hacer el esfuerzo de formar una familia cuando mucho de lo que nos rodea justifica una manera de pensar y de vivir que es radicalmente opuesta a la voluntad de Dios. Supongo que es por eso que Jesús llama el camino a la vida eterna un camino estrecho. Él dijo que es imposible para un hombre perseverar sobre este camino, solamente por la gracia de Dios.

Estamos pasando por tiempos inestables y grandes conmociones. El mundo está tambaleando al borde del precipicio de la destrucción mutua y cósmica. Creo que Dios está llamando a los cristianos a un discipulado radical para contrarrestar los golpes de las fuerzas nefastas que están poniendo presión sobre nosotros. En un tiempo como este la credibilidad de la Iglesia es amenazada por la renuencia de proclamar el consejo total de Dios. ¿Quién puede identificarse con una Iglesia que aguada las enseñanzas de la vida, muerte, y resurrección de Jesús? Tal tendencia sólo hace la Iglesia irrelevante. Tenemos una tendencia de pensar que el hacer amistad con el mundo al costo de la verdad nos ganará el respeto del mundo. Jesús hizo lo opuesto. El mundo siempre estará en enemistad con la Iglesia.

Esos fragmentos de sonido de *amor* que son usados para justificar el comportamiento del hombre que contrarrestan los mandamientos de Dios han sido pervertidos al costo del bienestar de nuestro futuro. Esto sólo acelera la inminente conmoción cósmica de la cual se habla en las Sagradas Escrituras. Con firmeza los cristianos deben abrazar con humildad y misericordia el mandamiento de *amar* en todo el sentido de la palabra. A imitación de Cristo Jesús vivimos por amor del Padre para que así nuestros sacrificios por amor a Él traigan fruto para la salvación de aquellos quienes amamos y aquellos quienes no amamos como deberíamos. Como dijo Jesús, *No hay más grande amor que el que demos nuestras vidas por la de nuestros amigos.*

Las Sagradas Escrituras nos enseñan que al final de los tiempos los poderes del cielo serán estremecidos. Esto es inevitable. Antes de la segunda venida de Cristo la Iglesia debe pasar por la prueba final que sacudirá la fe de muchos creyentes, pero el misterio de iniquidad será dado a conocer y al final, todos verán al Hijo del Hombre venir con gran poder y gloria para reclamar lo que es Suyo y el Reino será realizado. Pidamos por la gracia de perseverancia final para que así al final de todas las cosas podamos ser contados entre los sabios quienes brillarán como las estrellas por siempre y para siempre.

HEATING SYSTEM PROJECT

Dear Friends,

Thanks to your generosity and to the generosity of an anonymous donor who covered a great amount of the cost of the new boiler we were able to raise enough funds to replace the parish's entire heating system. This project allowed us to upgrade every aspect of the church and rectory heating infrastructure which had no be done in many decades. This is a major capital improvement to our parish infrastructure which positions our parish to effectively function well into the future.

We now have state-of-the-art steam boilers, along with new circulation pumps, new vacuum pumps, new feed tank, new zone valves, new thermostats, new controls, new gas burners, and the replacement of piping along with insulation in the steam tunnels that run beneath the rectory and church.

Lastly, this upgrade will lower our annual heating costs helping us toward the goal of lowering operating costs of the parish while running the facilities as efficiently as possible.

Thank you again for a successful campaign to upgrade our church and rectory heating system.

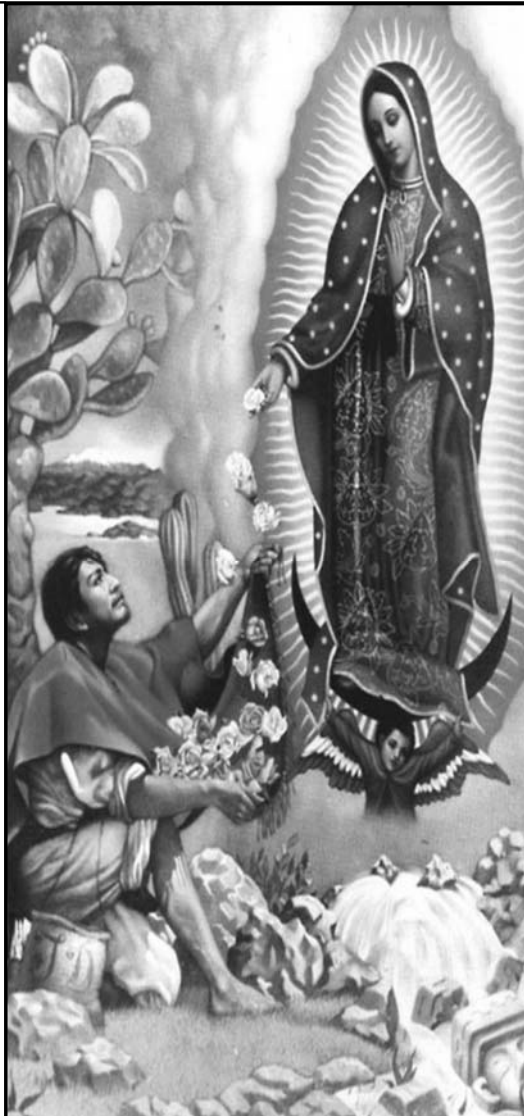

HOW WE PRAY AT ST. STANISLAUS KOSTKA

WE KEEP OUR DOORS OPEN ALL DAY AND ALL NIGHT:

We listen. In response to the call of the Blessed Virgin Mary we strive to create quiet refuge from the labor of life's journey where the soul is opened to the transforming power of God's ever abiding presence. The grace of the *Holy Eucharist* will assist a covenant people on its return to childlike trust in Jesus, provide healing and strength, and inspire enthusiasm for the work of life. Therefore we wish to safeguard sacred silence in this sanctuary that God's voice is heard in the deep recesses of the soul.

WE OFFER THE SACRED MYSTERIES AD ORIENTEM:

The *Sacred Mysteries* are offered as they were for nearly 2000 years. Today, while the *ordinary form* for offering the *Holy Eucharist* has the priest facing the *sacred assembly*, here we follow an ancient form of the *Holy Offering*, the priest and the people together, raising their eyes to the *East* from where the Lord will come at the end of all things.

This option for offering the *Sacred Mysteries* was nearly universally eclipsed in the aftermath of the Second Vatican Council beginning in the mid-1960s, but Pope Benedict, Cardinal Sarah, and other Church Fathers have inspired a resurgence of this ancient gesture for offering the *Liturgy of the Holy Eucharist*.

At the *Altar of Sacrifice*, the *priest* lays down his life and the *sacred assembly* does likewise. This is our mutual *fiat* – our *yes* spoken and offered in thanksgiving that the Lord receive us as a people in need of redemption. The Lord indeed comes to us with redeeming grace. Together, priest and people offer themselves in Christ and through Christ to the Father. Ours is a plea that God make all things new and keep us on the narrow, but difficult path that serves humanity even as it carries us to the homeland. Our turning *Ad Orientem* facilitates a proper response to having been fed with the *Word of God* as well as an appropriate preparation for the *Supper of the Lamb*.

WE OFFER TWO OPTIONS FOR THE RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION:

After the Second Vatican Council, standing for reception of the *Holy Eucharist* became the norm and fits the directives of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. Nonetheless, kneeling to receive Jesus in *Holy Communion* is in keeping with the enduring tradition of our ancestors. Today the option to kneel or stand rests with the individual. Likewise, the option to receive the *Holy Eucharist* on the tongue or on the hand rests with the individual.

Whichever manner we choose to receive Jesus in the *Holy Eucharist*, let us be conscious of this sacred and life sustaining encounter. Let us receive Him in grace and with gratitude, humbly and in humility.

God speaks to us every day. You can hear Him if you listen. *Contemplatives in Action* is a group of men and women who are seeking to find "God in all things." Through the Examen Prayer of St. Ignatius Loyola we see how the Lord is working in our lives in the moments of each day.

We contemplate the word of God. "Contemplation" is the word St. Ignatius used to describe the type of prayer he recommends in that part of the Spiritual Exercises where he shows us how to grow in intimacy with our Lord. After listening to the Gospel, we have a conversation about how the Lord is speaking to us and inviting us to respond through our actions.
