LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today's gospel provides the means to maintain sanity and interior peace when so much around us threatens to further disturb the civility of society. It is really quite simple. Acknowledge that only God is perfectly good. Obey the commandments of God. Put Christ first, above all people and all things, and give your life completely to Him. Know that this is not at all easy and nearly impossible. In fact, Jesus said, for human beings it is impossible, but not for God. God provides the grace. We need only open our souls to the gift.

If we strive daily to do these things, God will be generous in bestowing on us His blessings, but that doesn't mean the mob will go away. The Lord said, fulfilling His will brings a hundred-fold more than what we give, but persecution besides. So be it. If persecution is the price we pay to maintain sanity and interior peace it is a cost well made.

Let us not lose our minds in this age when every dark thing under the sun is exposed to the point that the good sadly seems eclipsed. Let us not lose our minds when the rude noise of the world can be so deafening that we'd almost swear that God has indeed been shouted into silence. The rosary is the chain that brings all things good into the light and opens the ears anew to the sound of God's voice. Hence we acquire prudence and wisdom and are undisturbed by the sounds and sights of the mob.

I conclude here with a reminder that next Sunday, October 21st at the 10:00 a.m. Mass I wish to acknowledge all those who, while members of other parishes, come to St. Stanislaus Kostka for adoration throughout the week. As one of our parishioners said, "*Here the Lord makes disciples one adorer at a time.*" Those who come here during the week at all hours of the day and night are vital to the mission of St. Stanislaus Kostka, *Sanctuary of the Divine Mercy*. They are the *anawim* being formed by the Blessed Virgin Mary to bring the sanity and peace so needed today.

As I speak of sanity and peace let me remind all of you to invite police officers, fire fighters, and first responders to the *Blue Mass* we will celebrate on Sunday, October 28th at 10:00 a.m. Without these men and women we would indeed suffer the loss of a civil society. They are indispensable to the protection and well-being of our sojourn through this life.

HEATING SYSTEM PROJECT

Dear Friends,

Thanks to your generosity and to the generosity of an anonymous donor who covered a great amount of the cost of the new boiler we were able to raise enough funds to replace the parish's entire heating system. This project allowed us to upgrade every aspect of the church and rectory heating infrastructure which had not been done in many decades. This is a major capital improvement to our parish infrastructure which positions our parish to effectively function well into the future.

We now have state-of-the-art steam boilers, along with new circulation pumps, new vacuum pumps, new feed tank, new zone valves, new thermostats, new controls, new gas burners, and the replacement of piping along with insulation in the steam tunnels that run beneath the rectory and church.

Lastly, this upgrade will lower our annual heating costs helping us toward the goal of lowering operating costs of the parish while running the facilities as efficiently as possible.

Thank you again for a successful campaign to upgrade our church and rectory heating system.

HOW WE PRAY AT ST. STANISLAUS KOSTKA

WE KEEP OUR DOORS OPEN ALL DAY AND ALL NIGHT:

We listen. In response to the call of the Blessed Virgin Mary we strive to create quiet refuge from the labor of life's journey where the soul is opened to the transforming power of God's ever abiding presence. The grace of the *Holy Eucharist* will assist a covenant people on its return to childlike trust in Jesus, provide healing and strength, and inspire enthusiasm for the work of life. Therefore we wish to safeguard sacred silence in this sanctuary that God's voice is heard in the deep recesses of the soul.

WE OFFER THE SACRED MYSTERIES AD ORIENTEM:

The *Sacred Mysteries* are offered as they were for nearly 2000 years. Today, while the *ordinary form* for offering the *Holy Eucharist* has the priest facing the *sacred assembly*, here we follow an ancient form of the *Holy Offering*, the priest and the people together, raising their eyes to the *East* from where the Lord will come at the end of all things.

This option for offering the *Sacred Mysteries* was nearly universally eclipsed in the aftermath of the Second Vatican Council beginning in the mid-1960s, but Pope Benedict, Cardinal Sarah, and other Church Fathers have inspired a resurgence of this ancient gesture for offering the *Liturgy of the Holy Eucharist*.

At the *Altar of Sacrifice*, the *priest* lays down his life and the *sacred assembly* does likewise. This is our mutual *fiat* – our *yes* spoken and offered in thanksgiving that the Lord receive us as a people in need of redemption. The Lord indeed comes to us with redeeming grace. Together, priest and people offer themselves in Christ and through Christ to the Father. Ours is a plea that God make all things new and keep us on the narrow, but difficult path that serves humanity even as it carries us to the homeland. Our turning *Ad Orientem* facilitates a proper response to having been fed with the *Word of God* as well as an appropriate preparation for the *Supper of the Lamb*.

WE OFFER TWO OPTIONS FOR THE RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION:

After the Second Vatican Council, standing for reception of the *Holy Eucharist* became the norm and fits the directives of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. Nonetheless, kneeling to receive Jesus in *Holy Communion* is in keeping with the enduring tradition of our ancestors. Today the option to kneel or stand rests with the individual. Likewise, the option to receive the *Holy Eucharist* on the tongue or on the hand rests with the individual.

Whichever manner we choose to receive Jesus in the *Holy Eucharist*, let us be conscious of this sacred and life sustaining encounter. Let us receive Him in grace and with gratitude, humbly and in humility.

Salaries	\$142,920	\$11,910	\$2,748	Salaries of staff: pastor, operations director for church/school, secretary, CCD director, 2 organists, accounting assistant. We save money because we have 1 priest serving entire parish in 3 languages, share operations director 50% of time with another parish, have only 2 full-time staff (pastor/secretary), do not have any maintenance staff. Church cleaning/maintenance done volunteered.
Health Insurance	\$25,920	\$2,160	\$498	Health insurance of pastor, 50% of operations director, secretary.
Employer FICA	\$7,491	\$624	\$144	Federally required employment taxes that must be paid.
Fringe Benefits	\$8,060	\$672	\$155	Employee pension, basic life insurance, social security benefits.
Ministry	\$2,000	\$167	\$38	Support of various church ministries.
Books & Supplies	\$5,000	\$417	\$96	Bulletin printing, offertory envelope printing, CCD books.
Administrative Expenses	\$15,000	\$1,250	\$288	Church database software, postage, payment processing, payroll processing, Brink's secure transportation, copy machine, service fees.
Transportation	\$3,600	\$300	\$69	Priest vehicle lease and vehicle repair.
Food Service & Meals	\$6,000	\$500	\$115	Priest meal allowance.
Telephone	\$3,700	\$308	\$71	Cost of landline and cell phone service, line charges, internet.
Heating Fuel	\$40,000	\$3,333	\$769	Cost for heating church/rectory. In very cold winters, this can increase annual cost up to \$50,000. Note this is higher cost than in most parishes since we are open all day and night.
Electricity	\$20,000	\$1,667	\$385	Cost of electricity to light church and rectory. Note this is higher than in most parishes since we are open all day and night so church lights are on all night.
Other Utilities	\$4,000	\$333	\$77	Garbage pick-up. This used to be a free service to all churches but now the city requires parish to pay a private garbage company for garbage disposal.
Maintenance	\$10,000	\$833	\$192	We keep our maintenance costs to a minimum but we still need to buy cleaning supplies, pay for snow removal & salting of parking lots (average \$4000/year), emergency heat company calls, sewer rodding, organ tuning, minor repairs.
Adoration Security	\$45,260	\$3,772	\$870	Keeping the church open 24/7 has security costs associated with it. We have security at night to keep our sanctuary safe for Adorers. This is an expense that is integral to our mission. Atlas Security has generously donated \$6,000 of security hours to help us offset this cost.
Altar & Liturgical Supply	\$21,000	\$1,750	\$404	Hosts/wine, votive/vigil lights, candles, missalette/liturgical publications, flowers
